    - (b) Not less than 1 and not more than 8 members elected at the Annual General Meeting, who shall hold office from the conclusion of the meeting.
  - (iii) The Committee may in addition to 6 (ii) appoint not more than **3** co-opted Members who shall have full voting rights and have tenure until the next AGM". and that Item 7 read as follows:
  - 7. Election of Officers/Committee Members
  - (i) The election of members of the Committee shall be held at the AGM of the U3A.
  - (ii) The newly elected Committee shall take office at the conclusion of the AGM. The Officers and other voting members of the committee shall be Trustees of the Charity.
  - (iii) Officers and Committee Members shall serve a period of 1 year. Retiring Officers and Committee Members may stand for re-election provided that no one may hold a single specific office, as defined in 6(i), for more than 3 consecutive years without an intervening period of at least one year. The maximum total period of service of any trustee shall be 9 years in any combination of roles whether or not the periods are contiguous."
